

Multi Desktop Live DVD

For Intel-compatible, 32 and 64-bit computers

Ensure that your DVD drive is capable of reading dual-layer DVD discs and that your computer is configured to boot from the DVD drive. Insert the disc into the DVD drive, and restart your computer.

At the boot menu, select your preferred desktop environment. If you are unsure, simply press ENTER to select the default. The boot loader will automatically detect your CPU, but you may select a 32-bit or 64-bit image manually.
